Defining love of God as loving the brothers

4:21 And this commandment we have from God:

that <u>everyone who</u> *loves* God must also *love* <u>his brother and sister.</u>

5:1 Everyone who trusts that Jesus is the Messiah has been fathered by God.

And everyone who loves this Father must also love anyone God has fathered.

Defining love of God as obeying his commands

5:2 By this we know that we *love* God's children, when we *love* God and obey his commandments, 5:3a for [REASON] this is what it means to *love* God, that we keep his commandments.

Defining the empowerment of this love—trusting in Jesus

5:3b And his commandments aren't burdensome,

5:4 because [REASON] <u>everyone who</u> has been <u>fathered by God</u> ...conquers the world.

And this is the conquering that has conquered the world—our trust.

5:5 And who is it that *conquers the world...*

but everyone who trusts that Jesus is God's Son?
